

Provincial Proof of Vaccination Requirements

Effective September 22, 2021, as per <u>Provincial regulation</u>, patrons seeking access to the Lucan Community Memorial Centre must show proof of identification and proof of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19 before they can enter the facility, with limited exceptions.

An individual is considered to be fully vaccinated if they have received:

- The full series of a COVID-19 vaccine authorized by Health Canada, or any combination of such vaccines, or
- One or two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine not authorized by Health Canada, followed by one dose of a COVID-19 mRNA vaccine authorized by Health Canada, or
- Three doses of a COVID-19 vaccine not authorized by Health Canada; and
- They have received their final dose of the COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days before providing proof of being fully vaccinated.

Patrons should plan to arrive at our facility approximately 30 minutes before their scheduled time.

All patrons will be met and asked to provide the following documents prior to entry:

- A paper or downloaded copy of their full dose Vaccine Certificate(s)
- Proof of identity showing the name and date of birth (e.g., Birth Certificate, Citizenship Card, Driver's Licence, Government-Issued Identification Card, i.e. Health Card, Indian Status Card, Passport or Permanent Resident Card)
