MINUTES

Review of minutes from previous meeting. Motion made by Chad to accept the minutes from previous meeting. 2^{nd} by Cindy. Motion passed.

Motion by Les to accept the Recommendations – 2^{nd} Barb. All in favour and motion was passed.

Lesley discussed that Don McKee is willing to come to Lucan and run an off ice session for our coaches which would focus on Motivation, Practice Planning, Game Management etc. Date and time to be set and coaches to be advised.

• OMHA – Chris

Bantam update provided. We will not be able to host a Bantam Rep team again this year, and will work with players who wish to attend tryouts at neighbouring centers.

Midget Update provided. We will not be able to host a Midget rep team this year.

Chris advised the group the OMHA is once again mandating Gender Diversity Team Talks early in the season. Info to be distributed to coaches and discussed at pre-season coaches meeting.

With another year of not being able to provide Rep hockey at Bantam and Midget boys, Chris mentioned its advisable that we review our options to align with local centers for a rep program moving forward.

• Ice – Mark

Met with Paul from the Township to review preliminary ice schedule Will draft a development and tryout ice schedule in the next week.

• Fundraising – Jenny

• Shamrock - Scott

Scott was away, and Chad provided updates on Scotts behalf.

Reviewed Novice Boys numbers, and recommended that we move some players from Minor Novice to Novice and run two teams, a rep and a LL team at Novice. We then run two teams at Minor Novice, with team split to be determined based on LMLL structure. All in agreement.

Concerned about numbers at PW Boys. Right now, with 30 skaters, that's either 2 big teams or 3 small teams, neither option desirable. Try to recruit more players by discussing with neighboring centers.

Shamrock meeting upcoming on Aug $10^{\rm th}$, and will determine Novice programming and when tryouts need to start.

As agreed at previous meeting, we will mix our 7 & 8 year olds and run two Novice Girls teams. Our intention will be to run a Tier 1 and a Tier 2 team.

WOGHL intends to run a "B" division this year which would reduce travel for centers interested in playing.

With a large team in Midget, our recommendation is to enter into WOGHL, which will allow flexibility with game lengths and LLFHL mandates 10-10-12 games below "A" hockey.

Keith has worked with a local company to and has come up with a proposal to improve storage capabilities in the coaches room and storage room off of dressing room #6. Final costs to be confirmed prior to next meeting.

Will get a cost of practice pinnies with numbers front and back which will help with evaluations and can also be used for teams in practices.

Keith has a quote for higher temporary boards to be used for ½ ice games. Dasher boards with similar style as permanent boards would be approx.. \$9000. Higher padded dividers would be approximately \$900. No decision taken.
